- Grammar and usage are correct
- Spelling, capitalization, and punctuation are correct. If handwritten, the narrative is legible.

- Some grammatical and usage errors
- Several spelling, capitalization, and punctuation errors occur. If handwritten, the writing is mostly legible.

- Grammar and usage are incorrect in many places, but the writer's ideas are still clear.
- Spelling, capitalization, and punctuation are often incorrect but do not make comprehending the story difficult. If handwritten, writing may be partially illegible.

2.5

- Many grammatical and usage errors change the meaning of the writer's ideas.
- Spelling, capitalization, and punctuation are incorrect throughout. If handwritten, the writing may be partially or mostly illegible.

Please note the following penalties for specific mistakes:

- Using lower case i for personal pronoun I: 10 points off per instance
- Failue to capitalize proper nouns: 10 points off per instance
- Run-on sentence or sentence fragment: 5 points off per instance
- Subject-verb agreement error: 5 points off per instance

10 Completeness

Scored as a percentage. For example, if the exercise has four items, and the student completes three, the score would be 7.5. Points are also taken off if an item is not completed as directed by the instructions.

10 Correctness

Scored as a percentage. For example, if the exercise has four items, and three are completed correctly and one incorrectly, the score would be 7.5. Please note that if a student does not complete an item, they will lost points on both Completeness and Correctness.
